World Class Centre for Excellence

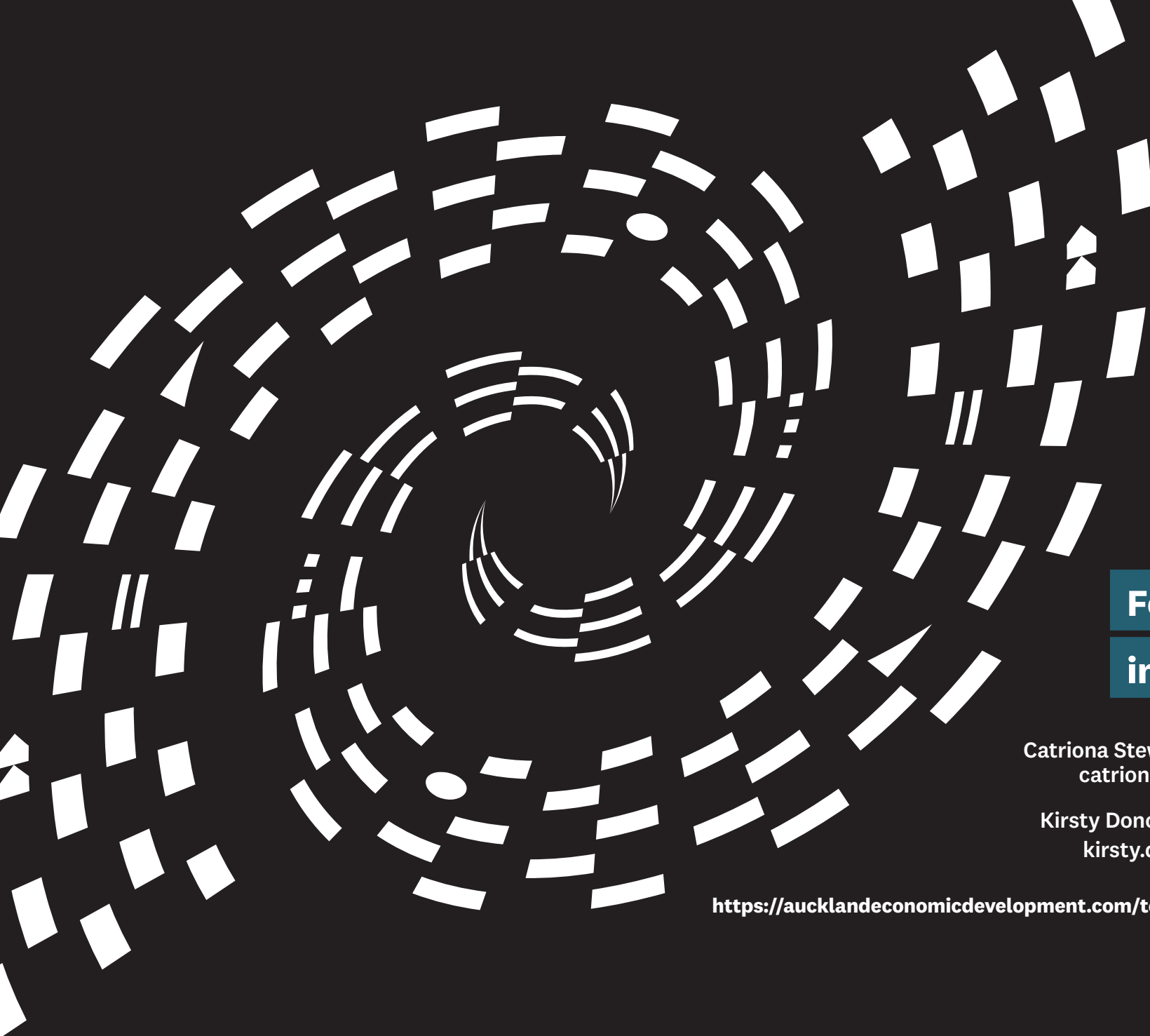
Te Puna Creative Innovation Quarter aspires to be a world-class centre of excellence for creative industries in Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland—a hub for innovation in screen, gaming, creative tech, music, arts, and performing arts like no other.

Indigenous Innovation Partnership: Driven by a partnership between Auckland Council, Auckland’s economic development office and Te Kawerau ā Maki, the mana whenua authority for West Auckland, this initiative reflects Te Kawerau ā Maki’s tribal value of auaha (creativity and innovation) and their long-standing support for Henderson’s creative industries sparking collaborative innovation that bridges traditional knowledge with cutting-edge technology.
