The studio's concrete floor and roller-door access ensure easy equipment loading and setup, while the 6m x 5m lighting rig provides professional-grade illumination. With black curtain coverage creating the perfect controlled environment, this adaptable space seamlessly transforms from film set to rehearsal studio or performance space.



Step through the striking high-stud glass entrance into the Grand Foyer, where soaring ceilings and natural light create an impressive welcome space at the heart of Te Puna Creative Hub. The red carpet runs the full length, creating a theatrical pathway that connects guests to both Komanawa Theatre and The Grounds resturant. 
The Grounds



Te Puna Creative Innovation Quarter



Indigenous Innovation Partnership: Driven by a partnership between Auckland Council, its economic development office and Te Kawerau ā Maki, the mana whenua authority for West Auckland, this initiative reflects the iwi tribal value of auaha (creativity and innovation) and their long-standing support for Te Kōpua Henderson's creative industries. This collaborative innovation bridges traditional knowledge with cutting-edge technology.

Strategic Development Vision: Bordered by Keeling Road and Great North Road, and part of the Development Auckland's Unlock Henderson urban regeneration area, Te Puna Creative Innovation Quarter will create a circuit of creative industries linking Henderson village, Corban Estate Arts Centre, Laidlaw College and Auckland Film Studios.
